Topics discussed included:

- background on the company;
- the approach, working with the municipality to collect data on what they want, then taking the information the town gave and making a lighting design, financing options, installation management, and maintenance management;
- project pricing and scope;
- savings analysis;
- Smart Control options that can give the ability to track power with GPS with a cellular transceiver;
- other options noted that are available include cameras, air quality monitoring, public wi-fi, and EV Chargers.
- dimming and trimming can help maintain the lifespan of the lights. Options could be to dim in some areas not needed as much as high traffic areas or using diming in off-peak seasons vs on-peak.
