

## Persons Authorized to Solemnize Marriages in Maine

- If the officiant is a resident this state:
  - A justice or judge
  - A lawyer admitted to the Maine Bar; or
  - A notary public under Title 4, chapter 19
  
- Whether the officiant is a resident or non-resident of this State and whether or not a citizen of the United States:
  - An ordained minister of the gospel;
  - A cleric engaged in the service of the religious body to which the cleric belongs; or
  - A person licensed to preach by an association of ministers, religious seminary or ecclesiastical body.
