

## RULES

### PUBLIC PORTION OF BOOTHBAY HARBOR FISH PIER

The following rules were approved as operating guidelines for the public portion of the Boothbay Harbor Fish Pier.

A major portion of the pier is available for lease to private tenants as shown on the attached lot map. The remaining south side portion of the pier is primarily available for commercial fishery public access, with limited access by residents of Boothbay Harbor.

#### GENERAL RULES:

1. Leased space is under the control of a tenant and respective customers, and is to be considered proprietary for use by that tenant as governed by a lease with the Town of Boothbay Harbor.
2. The south side of the pier with ramp and floats, is primarily available for commercial fisheries public access, as governed by annual permits issued by the Town of Boothbay Harbor for vehicles, vessels and small boats, for the following uses:
  - a. Short-term ground-out/light repairs and maintenance;
  - b. Transfer of equipment and temporary (24 hour) storage of equipment on dock;
  - c. Temporary vehicle access/parking associated with above activities.
3. Any vessel or truck owner using the pier is responsible for any damages incurred, and must repair or arrange for repair of the damage within 30 days to the satisfaction of the Selectmen.
4. Users are responsible for clean up of any debris or waste materials they create.

For any and all of the above uses, the user must apply to the Town of Boothbay Harbor for a permit and validation sticker(s). The following rates apply:

**LIMITED USE:**

Per diem rate of \$25 (except ground-out at \$15), payable to the Town of Boothbay Harbor for limited or emergency uses not exceeding five days in a given year.

**GENERAL USE:**

Annual non-refundable fee for commercial fishermen:

Resident: \$150  
Non-resident: \$300

Bulk purchase of any ten (10) or more permits may be made, by any individual, at the following rates. Resident permits may only be used by Boothbay Harbor residents.

Resident: \$ 75  
Non-resident: \$150

Any combination of resident/non-resident may make up the ten (10) permits. Permits may not be resold at an amount higher than the above bulk rates.

**GENERAL PROHIBITIONS:** These prohibitions apply to persons using the premises.

1. Any use without a permit from the Town of Boothbay Harbor.
2. Discharge, disposal, or dumping of oil, dead fish, rubbish, refuse or debris on the pier or in the water.
3. Drinking intoxicating beverages on the pier or vessel.
4. Unloading of products for sale.
5. Leaving vehicle or vessel unattended other than tenders of 14' or less.
6. Berthing and overnight docking of vessels (except short-term maintenance of vessel at ground-out area).
7. Use of, or interference with, leased portions of the pier without express permission of tenant.

**APPLICATION FOR PERMIT:**

All applications for permits are subject to review by Town Manager or designee; a permit shall be denied to any person who does not meet the rules. There is no rebate of fees. A permit is issued for one calendar year and fee is due no later than January 31 of the year. The sticker must be affixed to the vehicle and/or vessel(s).

A permit will be issued by the Town Manager or designee within 30 days of receipt of a full application that identifies the following information:

**ENFORCEMENT:**

Enforcement of rules and regulation is designated by Selectmen to local law enforcement officers. Violation of these rules may result in a fine of not less than \$25.

The Selectmen and their agents will issue tickets for violations of the rules. The right to use the facilities may be suspended at any time by the Selectmen.
