INFORMATION

Listed below is a 3 week look ahead schedule for the Rt. 27 Corridor Improvement Project.

I would like to stress the fact that lane closures resulting in significant traffic delays will begin next week. The work we have done to date has mostly been for utility crossings in the road and short runs along the sides of the road. The next phase of work requires much longer work areas for the equipment and trucks to move and grade the different gravel layers. We will do everything that we can to minimize the impacts on the public but it is sure to be challenging.

Week of September 10 – September 16:

Mill Pavement on Rt. 27 (BRAS to Adams Pond Road)

Excavate / Place / Grade Subbase Gravel Rt. 27 (Back River Road to Adams Pond Road)

Haul and Place Base Gravel Rt. 27 (Back River Road to Adams Pond Road)

Week of September 17 – September 23:

Begin Rt. 27 Detour (Rt. 27 at BRAS to Common Drive)

Finegrade for Paving Rt. 27 (Back River Road to Adams Pond Road)

Pave Base on Rt. 27 (Back River Road to Adams Pond Road)

Excavate / Place / Grade Subbase Gravel Rt. 27 (Roundabout to Back River Road)

Week of September 24 – September 30:

Place / Finegrade Base Gravel for Paving Rt. 27 (Roundabout to Back River Road)

Remove Pavement (Old Firehouse Building to Roundabout)

Pave Base on Rt. 27 (Roundabout to Back River Road)

Place and Grade Gravels (Old Firehouse Building to Roundabout)

Lane closures on Rt. 27 will be an all day, every day occurrence on Rt. 27 beginning 9/11/17

Saturday work is anticipated and will happen on an as needed basis through the fall once pavement is removed from Rt. 27.

Please note that this schedule is subject to change based on weather and unforeseen conflicts and conditions.

Alternate route to get to Boothbay Harbor or East Boothbay via Hardwick Road

1. Upon turning from route 1 onto route 27 you will travel approximately 7 miles south
2. At the seven mile mark you will turn right onto Hardwick Road (the location of the Dolphin mini golf)
3. Proceed along Hardwick Road until you come to the intersection at Pension Ridge Road, turn right
4. In approximately 1.3 miles you will come to Back Narrows Road, turn right onto Back Narrows Road
5. Follow Back Narrows Road until you come to the Route 96 intersection

To Go to East Boothbay

1. Turn left onto Route 96

To Go to Boothbay Harbor

1. Turn right onto Route 96 until you reach the stop lights
2. At the stop lights take a left onto Townsend Avenue

Alternate route to get to Southport or West Boothbay Harbor via Adams Pond Road

1. Upon turning from route 1 onto route 27 you will travel approximately 8.6 miles to get to Adams pond road
2. At the 8.6 mile mark, you will turn left onto Adams Pond Road
3. Take the next right onto Dover Road
4. In approximately 2 miles you will turn onto the Dover Cross Road on your left
5. When you reach the Back River Road intersection turn left onto Back River Road
6. When you reach the Corey Lane intersection (just past Clifford Park) turn right onto Corey Lane
7. In approximately 1.1 miles bear right onto Lakeside Drive
8. When you reach the four way intersection at Route 27-

Turn Left to Go to Boothbay Harbor

Turn Right to go to Southport
