Municipal Board Vacancies

The Board of Appeals has one regular member and two alternate member vacant positions available. The Board hears administrative appeals of Code Enforcement Officer decisions, hears variance requests from dimensional standards, and provides interpretive guidance for applicants, the Code Office, or the Planning Board. The Board consists of five regular members and two alternate members and meets on an as-needed basis.

The Planning Board has one alternate position available and meets monthly on the 2nd Wednesday of each month. This board consists of five regular members and two alternates.

The Port Committee has two alternate positions available. The committee meets on the 1st Tuesday of each month at 7:00 p.m. This committee advises on the management of our harbor activities.

Applications for appointment are available at the Boothbay Harbor Town Office and on the town website at www.boothbayharbor.org.
